- **Eligibility**- A senior student who wishes to follow their passion and dream in Media Arts and Photography.
- **Criteria**- Letter of recommendation, brief essay stating your career goals and challenges you face in continuing your education, and a high school transcript. Pick up application from Mrs. Romero.
- **Deadline**- April 5, 2010

NM Teen Pregnancy Coalition

- **Eligibility**-**Only students who fall in the above categories will be considered for a NMTPC scholarship.**
- **Category I**- senior who is pregnant or parenting and is planning to pursue a college or post secondary education.
- **Category II**—Is for a senior who has been actively involved in strategies for the prevention of teen pregnancy. Please pick up applications from Ms. Romero.

- **Eligibility-** HS graduating senior, born in NM, gpa Category I- 3.0, category II 2.4, must live in the North Valley
- **Criteria-** Submit official transcript, complete application and short essay, official transcript. 2 sealed letters of recommendation. Pick up application from Mrs. Romero.
- **Deadline-** April 15, 2010

2010 Student-View Scholarship Program

- **Eligibility-** Log on to www.student-view.com and complete a 15-20 minute application survey about colleges in your area. The scholarship will be awarded via a random drawing of all completed applications.
- **Deadline-** April 22, 2010

****First Choice Community Health Scholarship**

- **Criteria-** Entering a health-related course of study, minimum GPA 2.5, community involvement, preference will be given to students attending publicly supported NM Schools. Pick up application from Mrs. Romero.
- **Deadline-** April 23, 2010

Sussan-Miller Educational Assistance Award Program

- **Criteria-** Attend a public or nonprofit college or university full-time, must be a federal financial aid recipient.
- **Deadline-** April 23, 2010—out of state schools

- **Criteria-** Academic performance, involvement in the community, 500 word essay, two letters of recommendation. Pick up application from Mrs. Romero
- **Deadline-** April 30, 2010

- **Criteria-** Academic performance, 500 word essay detailing how the candidate has personally experienced a need to persevere, two letters of recommendation. Pick up application from Mrs. Romero

****Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., “High Aspirations” Scholarship**

- **Criteria-** Academic performance, involvement in the community, 500 word essay or less to articulate your own understandings of leadership, what you want to learn, and how you think the activity you have chosen will support your learning goals. Pick up application from Mrs. Romero
- **Deadline-** April 30, 2010

****Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., “Ernest Everett Just” Scholarship**

- **Criteria-** Demonstrate community involvement, 500 word essay “why the completion of a postsecondary program is important to you and what you hope to achieve once you get a degree in a science related field.’, two letters of recommendation, commitment to serve his/her community in the practice of science. Pick up application from Mrs. Romero
- **Deadline-** April 30, 2010

Tony Campman Memorial Scholarship

- **Eligibility-** Pursuing study in the water environment profession (biology, environmental science, engineering w/ as strong emphasis in wastewater treatment.
- **Criteria-**Essay question, relevance of course of study to the water environment profession. Letters of recommendation, GPA. Apply at www.rmwea.org
- **Deadline-** May 1, 2010

Bill Martin Memorial Scholarship

- **Eligibility-** Senior in good standing, who has applied to college or university with the interest of pursuing an environmental career. The winner must show proof of enrollment in the water environment-related program.
- **Criteria-** essay question, course of study to the water environment profession, letters of recommendation, GPA. Apply at www.rmwea.org
- **Deadline-** May 1, 2010

ExxonMobil Bernard Harris Math and Science Scholarships

- **Eligibility-** academic achievement in high school, leadership skills, community service in the area of Science, Technology, Engineering or Math. Must have a commitment to pursue a career in STEM field.
- **Criteria-** Must have a 3.0 gpa and have been accepted as a full-time student at a four year institution of higher education. Pick up application from Ms. Romero.
- **Deadline-** May 14, 2010

****Laguna Education Foundation Governor’s Scholarship**

- **Eligibility-** Laguna Tribal Member, 3.0GPA or higher, planning to attend a regionally post secondary institution.
- **Criteria-** Must answer 4 essay questions. Must consist of a minimum of one (1) double spaced typed page. Pick up scholarship application from Mrs. Romero
- **Deadline-** May 21, 2010

****Laguna Construction Company, Inc. Scholarship**

****C & D Scholarships**

- **Eligibility-** Cumulative GPA of **no greater than 2.4**, recommendation from teacher or counselor, attend post secondary school

- **Criteria-** essay no more than 350 words describing aspirations for the future, community involvement and goals. The essay should include obstacles the applicant has encountered and overcome. Transcript. Please pick up scholarship information from Mrs. Romero.
- **Deadline-** May 21, 2010

The Daisy Rice Annual Scholarship

- **Eligibility-**hearing impaired/deaf student.
- **Criteria-**Recent audiogram, statement of future goals, 3 letters of recommendation.
- **Deadline-** May 31, 2010

Sussan-Miller Educational Assistance Award Program

- **Criteria-** Attend a public or nonprofit college or university full-time, must be a federal financial aid recipient.
- **Deadline-**April 23, 2010—out of state schools or in-state private schools.
- **Deadline-**June 30, 2010—In state public schools

UNM Camp College Assistance Migrant Program

- **Eligibility-** Students or his/her parents must have spent a min. of 75 days during the past 24 months as a migrant or seasonal farm-worker.
- **Criteria-** Student must be enrolled or be admitted as a full-time student at UNM. Submit application at www.ceop.unm.edu/camp

UNM Bridge to Success Scholarship

- **Eligibility-**NM resident, High School GPA 2.5 or higher, enroll full-time (12 credits minimum) at the main campus in a Baccalaureate degree granting program.

Legislative Lottery Success Scholarship

- **Eligibility-** Be a NM resident. Earn at least 12 credit hours with a minimum 2.5 GPA during their first semester in college. This is a renewable full-tuition award, which may be received for up to eight consecutive semesters, beginning the student's second semester in college.

Albuquerque Community Foundation Student Aid Programs
