Tony Campman Memorial Scholarship

- **Eligibility-** Pursuing study in the water environment profession (biology, environmental science, engineering w/ as strong emphasis in wastewater treatment.
- **Criteria-**Essay question, relevance of course of study to the water environment profession. Letters of recommendation, GPA. Apply at www.rmwea.org
- **Deadline-** May 1, 2010

Bill Martin Memorial Scholarship

- **Eligibility-** Senior in good standing, who has applied to college or university with the interest of pursuing an environmental career. The winner must show proof of enrollment in the water environment-related program.
- **Criteria-** essay question, course of study to the water environment profession, letters of recommendation, GPA. Apply at www.rmwea.org
- **Deadline-** May 1, 2010

ExxonMobil Bernard Harris Math and Science Scholarships

- **Eligibility-** academic achievement in high school, leadership skills, community service in the area of Science, Technology, Engineering or Math. Must have a commitment to pursue a career in STEM field.
- **Criteria-** Must have a 3.0 gpa and have been accepted as a full-time student at a four year institution of higher education. Pick up application from Ms. Romero.
- **Deadline-** May 14, 2010

Laguna Education Foundation Governor's Scholarship

- **Eligibility-** Laguna Tribal Member, 3.0GPA or higher, planning to attend a regionally post secondary institution.
- **Criteria-** Must answer 4 essay questions. Must consist of a minimum of one (1) double spaced typed page. Pick up scholarship application from Mrs. Romero
- **Deadline-** May 21, 2010

Laguna Construction Company, Inc. Scholarship

- **Eligibility-** Enrolled Laguna Tribal Member, cumulative GPA 3.0. For more information go to www.LAGUNAEDFOUNDATION.ORG or see Mrs. Romero.
- **Deadline-** May 21, 2010

C & D Scholarships

- **Eligibility-** Cumulative GPA of **no greater than 2.4,** recommendation from teacher or counselor, attend post secondary school
- **Criteria-** essay no more than 350 words describing aspirations for the future, community involvement and goals. The essay should include obstacles the applicant has encountered and overcome. Transcript. Please pick up scholarship information from Mrs. Romero.
- **Deadline-** May 21, 2010

****2010 Charley Wootan Grant**

- **Eligibility-** **Only the first 6,000 submitted applications will be considered, so get you application in as soon as possible. The program is open to U.S. students demonstrating need who are eligible for federal financial aid funding.**
- **Deadline-** ASAP , May 22, 2010 apply at www.AIE.org/Wootan.

The Daisy Rice Annual Scholarship

- **Eligibility-** hearing impaired/deaf student.
- **Criteria-** Recent audiogram, statement of future goals, 3 letters of recommendation.
- **Deadline-** May 31, 2010

Sussan-Miller Educational Assistance Award Program

- **Criteria-** Attend a public or nonprofit college or university full-time, must be a federal financial aid recipient.
- **Deadline-** April 23, 2010—out of state schools or in-state private schools.
- **Deadline-** June 30, 2010—In state public schools

****Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Scholarship**

- **Eligibility-** Completed application form, official transcript, a recent, sharp and high gloss photograph of yourself. Three letters of reference teacher, principal or counselor, one personal reference.

- **Criteria-** Write an essay on Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. with min. length of 500 words and max. 525 words. Must write 2 more essays topics are provided on the application. Applications can be picked up from Mrs. Romero or apply online <http://www.mlkmc.com>
- **Deadline-** September 13, 2010

UNM Camp College Assistance Migrant Program

- **Eligibility-** Students or his/her parents must have spent a min. of 75 days during the past 24 months as a migrant or seasonal farm-worker.
- **Criteria-** Student must be enrolled or be admitted as a full-time student at UNM. Submit application at www.ceop.unm.edu/camp

UNM Bridge to Success Scholarship

- **Eligibility-** NM resident, High School GPA 2.5 or higher, enroll full-time (12 credits minimum) at the main campus in a Baccalaureate degree granting program.

Legislative Lottery Success Scholarship

- **Eligibility-** Be a NM resident. Earn at least 12 credit hours with a minimum 2.5 GPA during their first semester in college. This is a renewable full-tuition award, which may be received for up to eight consecutive semesters, beginning the student's second semester in college.
